### Project Description:

The consortium was commissioned by the BMBF to conduct a research project for the potential of micro financed renewable energy and energy efficiency solutions for mitigation and adaptation of climate change in Central Asia.

### Services provided:

- Desk study of climate change impacts in Central Asia and its interaction with renewable energy solutions, agriculture as the main economic driver, and microfinance
- Qualification of young scientists and recruitment of Master Thesis students.
- Stakeholder consultation (desk study and field research)
- Methods development for field mission in Kyrgyzstan, 2016
- Adaptation of a mapping tool (ME Atlas) to identify potential areas of intervention by green microfinance
- Implementation of a field study in Kyrgyzstan (October 2016), involving Stakeholder Consultations, MFI training on focus group conduction in the field of climate change, survey of 97 farmers, 20 expert interviews, student trainings
