- Desk study on the microenergy and microfinance sectors and initial technical mission to identify and pre-evaluate products and suppliers
- Support the recruitment of the technical energy officer

- Training of technical energy officers: Technical and financial trainings
- Pilot preparation: business planning; selection and validation of suppliers and technologies, capacity building of MFI staff, design of product conditions; establishment of procedure for MFI-client interface; establishment of relationships between MFIs and technical suppliers
- Pilot kick-off : Creation of call center; supervision of MFI pilot activities and design and supervision of quality control testing
